A. American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees District Council 20, Local 2743 v. Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs.

PERB Case No. 21-UC-03

Summary: AFSCME Local 2743 filed this petition for unit clarification. AFSCME seeks to clarify that certain employee positions within DCRA are included within its certified bargaining unit. The matter went to a hearing and the Hearing Examiner’s Report and Recommendations is before the Board.

B. American Federation of Government Employees, Local 631 and D.C. Office of State Superintendent of Education Division of Student Transportation

PERB Case No. 22-RC-01

Summary: AFGE has petitioned to represent a bargaining unit found appropriate for collective bargaining at OSSE. OSSE has submitted a statement that it will voluntarily recognize, without an election. The certification of the approved bargaining unit is now before the Board.

C. Teamsters Local Union No. 922, a/w International Brotherhood of Teamsters and D.C. Public Schools,

PERB Case No. 22-RC-02

Summary: Teamsters Local 922 filed a petition for recognition, seeking to represent a unit of employees at DCPS. The matter went to a hearing and the Hearing Examiner's Report and Recommendations is before the Board.

It was moved and seconded to close the meeting in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 2-575(b)(13). The motion passed unanimously. Following deliberations, the closed meeting session was reopened. The Board voted as follows:
